

18004 CARE Acts for Students:

The amount was determined by the number of Active Students on the 1st day of the of the date stated by DOE through the shutdown (distance ed) period, paid out to students by the end of the month of August. This will be completed through the Institutions bank account and checks were distributed to students in the same manner as credit balance checks. Each student was required to pick up in person and sign a receipt showing disbursement. We will track these transactions through the 18004 Cares Act – Student Emergency Financial Aid Distribution Records Reporting Schedule Tracker and Reporting Form Template. The amounts students will receive are determined by all active enrolled at the time of distance ed, and a questionnaire completed by individual students, the total amount allotted was divided by the number of qualifying students.

All students must fill out a Student Acceptance Document declaring their eligibility for the grant which is:

- A current active student clocking hours
- Title IV Eligible student
 - o Proof includes current FAFSA
 - o US Citizen or eligible non-citizen
 - o Males registered for selective service

**Note: If student is a cash paying student, they must complete a FAFSA in order to receive funds.
